

DALTON HIGHWAY

MP 379-397 and MP 397-415.2 RECONSTRUCTION

The Alaska Department of Transportation, in partnership with Cruz Construction and Brice, Inc., is working to reconstruct the Dalton Highway. Improvements include raising the grade, replacing culverts and surfacing the road. We will do our best to keep you informed as work progresses and appreciate your patience and cooperation during construction. These projects are expected to be complete by October 2017.

Planned Project Details:

MP 379 to 397:

- Work is expected to start at the end of May 2016.
- The project will include installing fish passage culverts and raising the grade of the highway to prevent flood damage.
- Expect additional truck traffic, commercial traffic and DELAYS.

MP 397 to 415.2:

- Work is expected to start at the beginning of June 2016.
- Upon completion, this section of the Dalton Highway will have raised grade, sturdier embankments, new culverts and a new crushed aggregate surface.
- Expect flagging and PILOT CAR operations with DELAYS.
