

# PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (DOT&PF) is planning to rehabilitate Chiniak Highway from milepost 15 to 31 in Kodiak, Alaska. The purpose of the project is to improve and preserve the roadway subgrade and surface.

#### PROPOSED WORK

- Paving
- Embankment Rehabilitation
- Roadway Realignments (easing or flattening grades and curves)
- Drainage and Culvert Improvements
- Rockfall Mitigation
- Guardrail Replacement
- Retaining Wall Structures
- Utility Relocations
- Signing and Striping

### **PROJECT PHASING**

The project will be phased over multiple construction projects based on the availability of funding, prioritization of improvements, and work type limits. See the figure to the left.
