

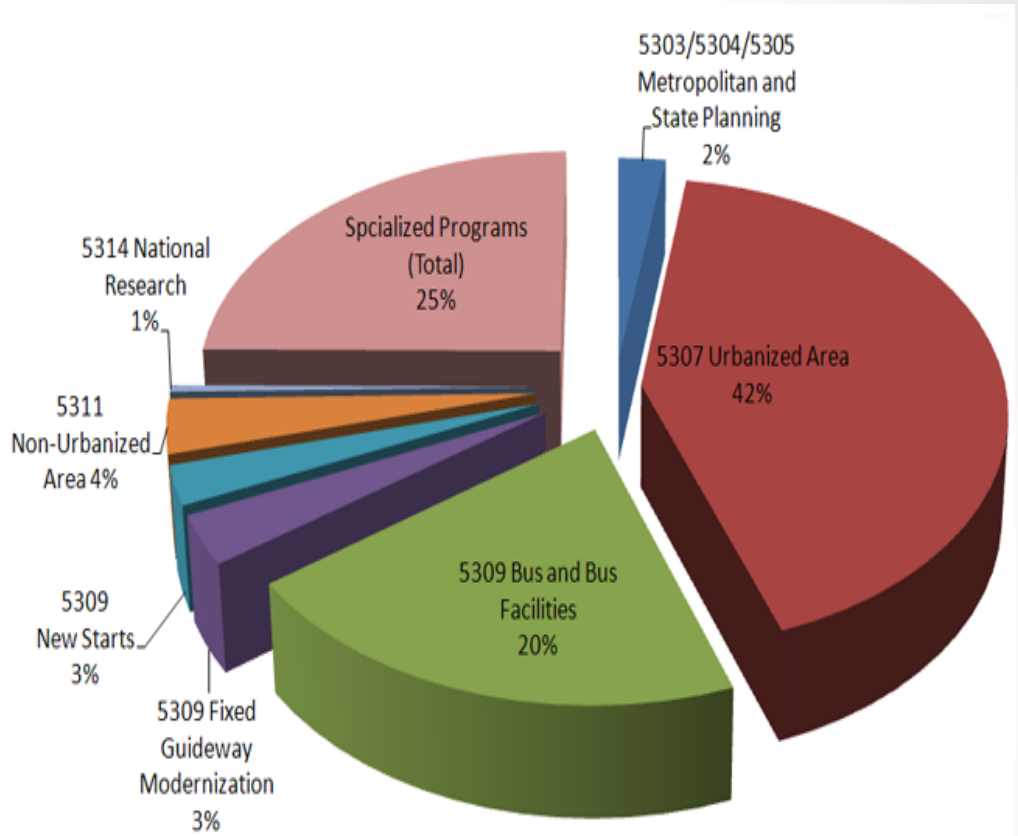

FY 2010 Grants Awarded By Program

SAFETEA-LU

- On August 10, 2005, President George W. Bush signed into law SAFETEA-U:
- **Safe, Accountable, Flexible, Efficient Transportation Equity Act: A Legacy for Users**

This statutory provision allows:

- Non-DOT funds can be used as match for JARC, NF, 5310 & 5311
- 5307 is expressed slightly different and permits contracts revenues to be used as match

Non-DOT funds CAN be used as match for FTA formula-related programs

- Medicaid
- TANF
- Employment Training
- Aging
- Community Services
- DVR
- Independent Living Council Programs
- Plus Many Others

Other Local Match Options

- Sales Tax
- Property Tax
- Utilities Tax
- Direct State Revenues
- Rural Mobility Funds
- STP (Oregon)
- Local Options
- PTBAA (Washington)

In-Kind Match

- DOCUMENTATION
 - DOCUMENTATION
 - DOCUMENTATION
- In-kind contributions are eligible as long as the value of each is documented and supported, represents a cost which would otherwise be eligible under the program, and is included in the net project costs in the project budget.
