***IRR WORKSHOPS IN FAIRBANKS ***

The UAF Alaska Tribal Technical Assistance Center will be conducting two Indian Reservation Roads (IRR) workshops in Fairbanks. The workshops are:

December 14 – 16, 2009*

TM 171: Introduction to the IRR Program (1 credit)

This course provides an introduction to the federal Indian Reservation Roads (IRR) program. The course will cover the history of the program, including recent program changes, and their applicability to and effect on Alaska Native Tribes. The fundamentals of implementing a Tribal IRR program will be presented. Students will develop a basic understanding of the IRR program, including the potential for implementation of this program within their Tribe. This course is designed for Tribal Administrators, Council Members, and Transportation Program Managers new to the IRR program.

December 16 – 18, 2009**

TM 293: Rural Transportation Planning (1 credit)

This course provides an introduction to the transportation planning process. The course will cover the Long Range Transportation Planning (LRTP) requirements of the Indian Reservation Roads (IRR) Program, the fundamentals of LRTP and plan update processes, and how these processes fit into the management of a rural transportation program. Students will participate in planning exercises and explore how these programs might be incorporated into their current transportation program. This course is designed for Council Members, Administrators, and Transportation staff.

The workshops will be held in the main classroom at the UAF Interior-Aleutians Campus in the Harper Building, 4280 Geist Road.
